

CHARLOTTE

2nd Early crop. With a creamy skin and light yellow flesh, they are relatively small potatoes. Charlotte potatoes have a fresh flavoured which tastes great either hot or cold. Ideal for salads, gratins, roasting and boiling, they hold their shape well.



INTERNATIONAL KIDNEY (like Jersey Royals)

Second early. Thin-skinned new potato (known as Jersey Royals when grown in Jersey) with rich buttery taste. Also do well if left in the ground for a month or so longer when they bulk up to a floury maincrop potato good for roasting, chips and wedges but no longer so good for boiling.



MARIS PIPER

Main crop. Good all-rounder, great for chips and roast potatoes, but also good for mash and wedges. Stores well.



PENTLAND JAVELIN

A superb tasting first early potato which takes a week or two longer than other first earlies to mature, a waxy variety best used boiled or in salads. It's possible to leave it in the ground longer which results in a more floury and larger potato.



DESIREE

Main crop. Popular red potato with pale yellow, firm waxy flesh. This potato has particularly good drought resistance. Potato 'Desiree' is versatile for all cooking purposes including roasting and baking.
